Contact-Tracing at school

Dear parents and legal guardians

In connection with the coronavirus, an important rule of conduct of the Federal Office of Public Health must continue to be observed: Persons with symptoms of the disease must remain in self-isolation and - if possible - be tested.

This means in the family environment:

- If your child has symptoms such as fever and/or cough, he or she must stay at home.
- If your child has already been tested, he or she must also stay at home until the results are available.

Schoolchildren who show symptoms at school will be sent home by the teacher, for children up to the 2nd primary class only after consultation with their parents.

In this case, you are requested to call the cantonal corona hotline (Tel. 052 632 70 01, weekdays 8.00-18.00) to plan the further steps for a possible corona test. As a rule, all symptomatic youths are tested.

For the well-being of your child and the whole school, please follow these rules of conduct. We thank you for your cooperation and wish you and your family good health.
